Other Interesting Dates

November 1... The town of Pompeii, Italy was buried by an eruption of Mt. Vesuvius in the year 79.

November 1... Susan B. Anthony registered to vote in Rochester, New York in 1872.

November 2... On this day in 1772, Boston patriot Samuel Adams, 50, and local physician Joseph Warren, 31, organized a Committee of Correspondence. Similar committees later sprang up throughout the colonies, relaying anti-British polemics.

November 4... King Tutankhamen's tomb was discovered in 1922. (King Tut died in 1323 B.C.).

November 7... Birthday of Marie Curie (1867). She discovered the element radium, paving the way for nuclear physics and cancer therapy.

November 8... Christiaan Barnard, the heart surgeon who performed the first heart transplant, was born in 1922.

November 8... X-rays discovered in 1895.

November 11... In 1620, forty-one pilgrims landed in Massachusetts and signed the Mayflower Compact.

November 11... In 1647, Massachusetts passed the first U.S. compulsory school attendance law.

November 14... Birthday of Frederick Banting, co-discoverer of insulin.

November 15... In 1777, the Articles of Confederation were adopted by the Continental Congress.

November 19... The Gettysburg Address was delivered by Abraham Lincoln in 1863.

November 27... The Nobel Prize was established in 1895.

November 30... Birthday of Hippocrates (460 B.C.), father of modern medicine.
